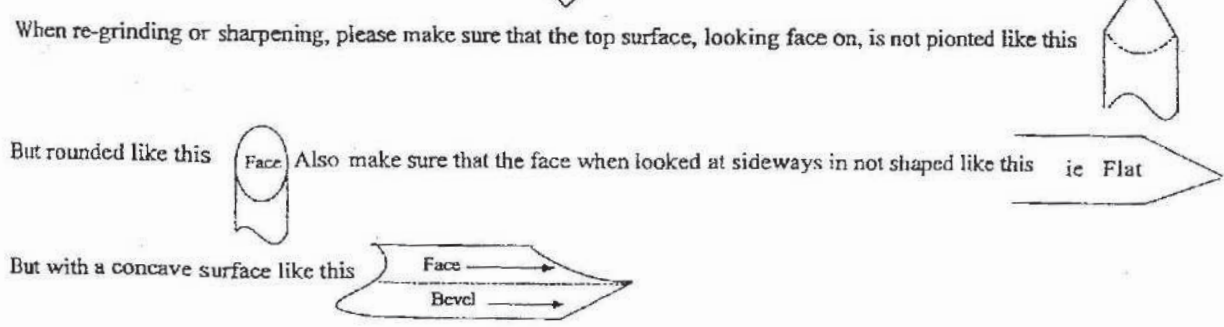
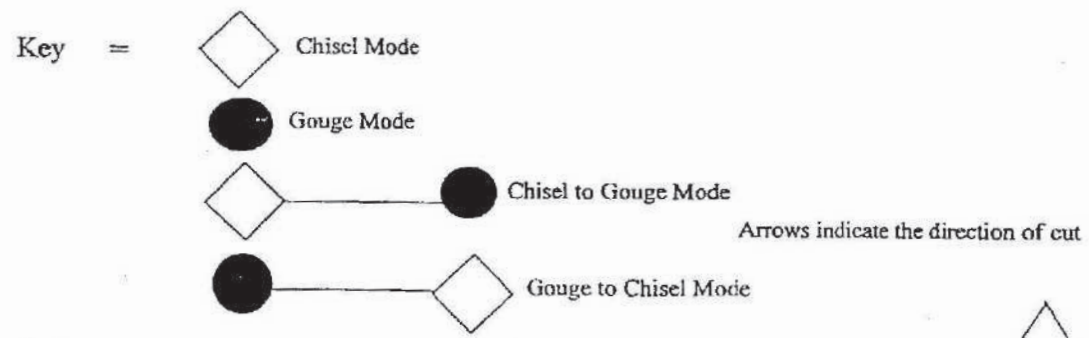
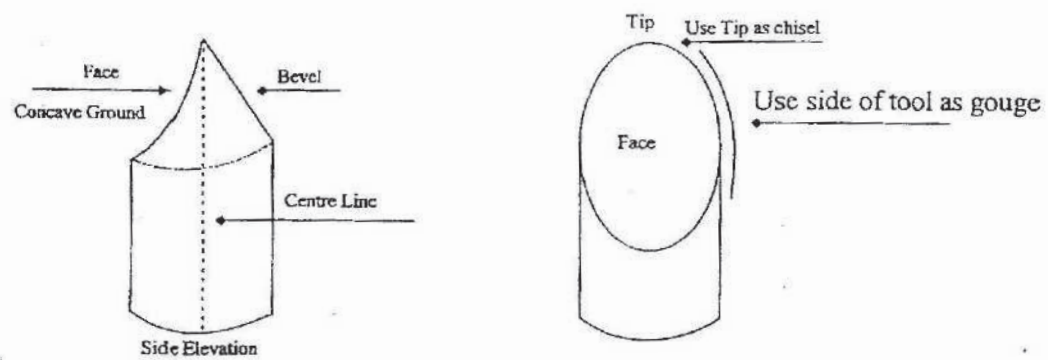
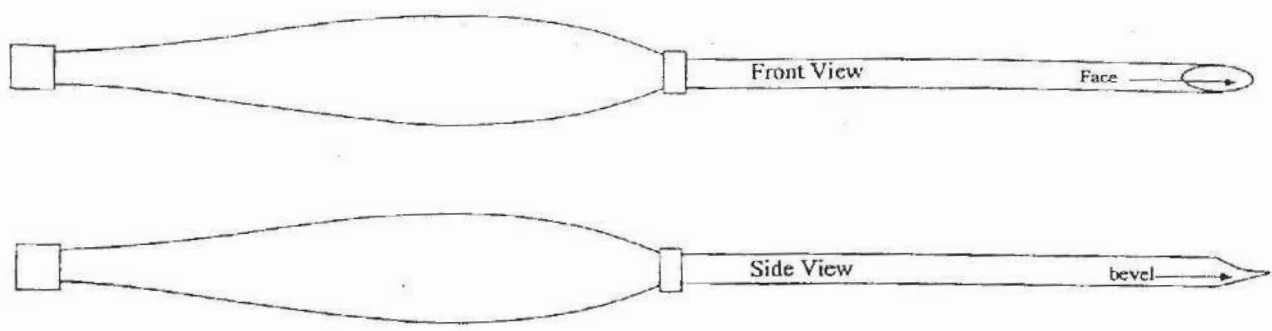


Instruction for the use of the BEECHAM skewchigouge

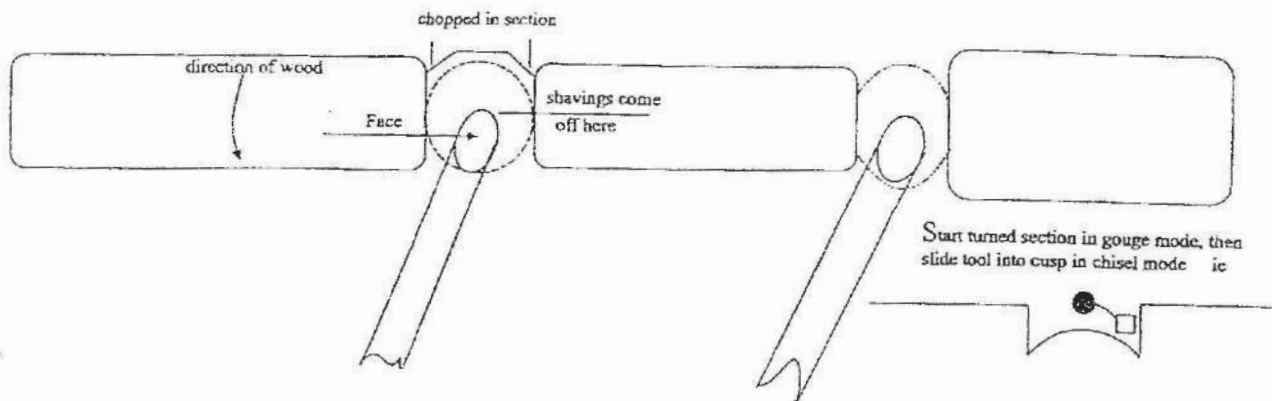


After roughing out to round, use the technique of "rubbing the bevel". This means that the tool should be placed on the "T" rest first, then the bevel should be rubbed on the revolving wood. Bring up the handle end slowly until the gouge starts to cut, then move the tool forwards into the direction of the cut, cutting and rubbing at the same time.

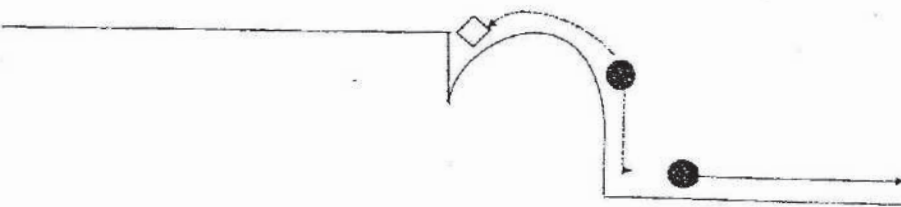
I hope you find the skewchigouge easy and fun to use.

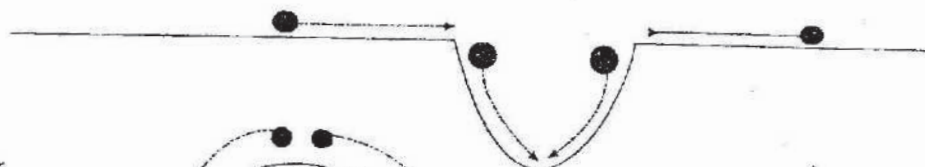
